Design a Christmas Card!



Instructions

Make sure drawings stay well within the black border on the drawing template – anything outside or drawn up to it will be cropped.

If the design is going to include writing, make sure this is clear of the black border.

Ensure the names are clearly readable at the bottom of the drawing template – ***we advise that this section is filled in by an adult***, as this ends up printed on the reverse of the card. Please use CAPITAL LETTERS.

For best results we recommend using Coloured Pencils (using a firm pressure and colouring in solidly), Felt Tips, Wax Crayons or Paint. Try using a light colour pen or coloured pencils rather than using dark green felt tip pen as this can come back looking very black. Please do not use glitter, metallic paper, highlighters or 3D objects on the drawing template as they give varying results on the final cards.

When the drawing is finished, please send back to your child's class teacher – they will be keeping a list of all those returned. **Drawings must be back by Thursday 21st October 9 am.**

If you want to, you can submit a family card, drawn by all siblings in the family together, rather than individual cards from each child.

We hope that as many families as possible will join in with this project, to help us raise lots of funds for the school. However, if for any reason you don't want to take part, please let your child's class teacher know so that we don't chase you for your child's design.

A few tips

You might want to look at some designs online, or encourage your child to practice their design a few times before they are let loose on the template! Your child might want to use a Nativity theme, or a traditional Christmas Celebrations designs, with decorations, tree, Father Christmas – it's up to you. Bold designs work best, so encourage the children to lay down lots of colour, especially if they are using Coloured Pencils. If they are including lettering, they will need to practise this first, and you might need to help with spelling!



There is a copy of the Template sheet on the school website if you need another or you have lost your original. Look under the Parents tab, and then in the Newsletter section.

What happens next

Once all the designs have been returned, they will be submitted to the printer. We should get proofs back **w/e 12th November 2021**. You will then receive a sample card, with an order form attached. You will need to send in your order ***promptly*** so that the PTFA can send the orders off. Finally, you will be sent the packs of finished cards/gifts, via your child's book bag **w/e 3rd December 2021**.
