

## **ANDREWS' ENDOWED SCHOOL UNIFORM**

After the last 18 months we are delighted that the children are back at school and we are starting the Autumn Term with a bit more "normality". We felt that it might be a good time to remind you of the school policy for uniform. We consider every child to be an ambassador for Andrews' Endowed School, and expect them to take pride in their appearance. Being smartly dressed in our distinctive purple school uniform gives our children a sense of belonging in our community. We do not want families to have to spend enormous amounts of money on uniform, so we try to keep the number of items with school logos to a minimum.

Our school uniform consists of:

Polo shirts	White – plain or school logo
Trousers (long or short)	Grey/Black
Skirts/pinafore dresses/culottes	Grey
Sweatshirts/cardigans	Purple with school logo
Dresses	Purple Gingham check
Socks	Plain grey, black or white ankle socks
Tights	Plain, not patterned, grey, black, white or purple
Coat	A warm winter coat of any type may be worn
Shoes	Black, brown or navy – easily fastened, of a sensible style which covers the toes for safety
Boots	May be worn to and from school in winter, but children should change into shoes on arrival
Wellingtons	All children should have a pair of named wellingtons in school during the wetter months.
PE Kit	Black shorts/cycling shorts House coloured t-shirt – Austen (Yellow), Cobbett (Red), Gaskell (Green), White (Blue) Trainers or plimsolls Dark unpatterned Jogging bottoms and a plain sweatshirt may be worn in cold weather <i>In the interests of healthy feet, on your child's PE day they should wear their school shoes to school with the plimsolls/trainers and socks in their PE bag (which can be left on their peg in school if preferred) so they are not wearing plimsolls/trainers all day.</i>

ALL clothing and equipment needs to be clearly marked with your child's full name. Checks need to be made regularly to ensure that the name label has not faded or disappeared.

Jewellery is not practical or safe for school wear, so we do not allow children to wear such items in school. We do not recommend pierced ears for the same reason, but where children do have their ears pierced only plain studs may be worn. These must be removed for PE, and stored by the child. We are not able to take responsibility for lost earrings. Pupils who cannot remove their own earrings will need to provide and use micro-pore tape to cover their earrings for PE.
