Maths
Read, order and compare numbers to a million. Use efficient written methods to add, subtract, multiply and divide whole numbers and decimals. Multiply and divide decimals by 10, 100 and 1,000. Begin to understand and use the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. Multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers. Suggest and use suitable units and measuring equipment to estimate or measure length, mass, capacity and time. Convert between metric units of measure. Solve one and two step problems. Reflect and translate 2D shapes on a grid. Compare, order, measure and calculate angles. Reason about 3D shapes.

Ancient History: The Mayans
Devise historically valid questions about change, cause, similarity and difference, and significance. Construct informed responses that involve thoughtful selection and organisation of relevant historical information. Understand how our knowledge of the past is constructed from a range of sources.
