### **Alton Walking Festival**



Alton Walking Festival, which is now in its 10th year, is a truly friendly walking event, ideal for enthusiastic walkers, relaxed wanderers and curious explorers of all ages. The festival is the ideal opportunity for the local community and visitors from further afield to meet like-minded people, explore the Town and its surrounding villages and discover the superb Hampshire countryside with its abundance of wildlife and rich cultural heritage.

We have received an amazing response already and are fully booked on the Dawn Chorus Walk (Walk 33), Foraging Walk (Walk 60) and Chawton House Estate Walk (Walk 85). A waiting list has been set up for all of the walks. Make sure you book now to avoid disappointment alton.gov.uk.

### **Free Energy Saving Measures**

People living in Alton in an energy inefficient home, which is owned or privately rented, and in receipt of benefits or on a low income could qualify for a grant of up to £10,000 worth of energy improvements.

The Green Homes Grant funding has been secured by East Hampshire District Council and will help to reduce the impact of skyrocketing energy prices.

The grants can cover measures including:

Wall insulation, Loft insulation, Renewable heating systems (such as air source heat pumps), Double/ triple glazing (to replace single glazing), Energy efficient doors and Thermostats and heating controls

Warmworks has been appointed as the managing agent for this scheme. They will work with residents through the process, checking that they - and their property - are eligible. They arrange the funding and installation and checking the quality of the work when it is done.

This round of funding will end on 31 March 2022 and installation should take place before the end of June 2022.


