Save the Date!

Raising money for NSPCC

The NSPCC are coming in to speak to the children on **Monday 10th June** about how to stay safe and we have chosen to support the charity's work further by taking part in a sponsored event. On Monday, your child will be bringing home a sponsor form detailing a sponsored 'Buddy's Big Workout'. 'Buddy's Big Workout' is a physical challenge that each class would have decided to complete. The workout will take place during the week beginning 17th June. Any sponsorship money that is collected can then be brought into school by the 24th June. By the time we get together, the conference room is set up for our meeting and our discussions can start. Today we debated some ideas raised from the classes, including 'How can we improve tidiness in our cloakrooms?' (lots of good ideas to take back to the classrooms, including a 'tidy peg' award) 'Should we be able to eat packed lunches outside in the summer?' (regrettably, no, because it would be difficult to make sure people ate safely and there was no litter left, no wasps bothering us, or food on clothes) and 'Could we have a typing club or some other way of improving our keyboard skills?' (yes, let's investigate how we can put some typing apps on our system for children to use). I am always amazed by the way the children can share their ideas, listen to and support each other, and then reach a vote at the end of each discussion so that there are outcomes to take back to the classes. I look forward to our next meeting on 23rd June.

Summer Term 2019 School Lunches

The cost for school lunches for the remainder of the Summer Term is £82.80 (36 lunches) or £11.50 per week. Although you can pay on a daily basis our preferred payment would be on a **weekly basis or paying a half term in advance**. This would cut down on daily cash handling in the office and ensure all dinner money is **paid in advance of the meal being taken**. If your child is ill, on a trip or decide they don't want a lunch the credit would be carried over to the following week. Please don't forget you can always use the online banking system which gives you the flexibility to pay by credit or debit card. Your child will still have the flexibility of opting to have a school dinner on a daily basis and any credit will roll over to the following week and you can keep a check of your child's account. If you are continuing to pay cash/cheque please can you ensure that all dinner money is put in a sealed envelope and clearly marked with your child's name and the amount enclosed and sent in via your child's class teacher and is paid in advance of the meal being taken.

School Uniform

The cut off for ordering new school uniform ready for September is **Thursday 20th June** – unfortunately any orders received after this date will not be fulfilled until September and you won't get items until at least second or third week if items are out of stock – thank you.

Payments for School Lunch, Breakfast Club, After School Club and Class Trip

Please can you ensure that all payments are kept up-to-date and ensure that all final payments are made by **Friday 19th July** to include any lunches or Breakfast and After School Club sessions for the last two days. All on-line payments for school trips must be made by this date. If the trip has now happened please can you check SCOPAY to ensure that you have paid any outstanding amounts – thank you.

Birthday Books

Don't forget to return the slip requesting a "birthday book" the Wednesday before your child's birthday. Your child will then get the opportunity to select a book of their choice which they will get the chance to show to the school at the next Celebration Worship.

You can apply on line at www.coolmilk.com or by paper application (copies held in the school office). You must register your child by **Tuesday 5pm** to start receiving milk the following week. If your child is in Acorns and under 5 they will receive milk FREE but you must ensure that your child is registered **before** their 5th birthday if you wish your child to continue with milk.
