We have sent letters home today to make arrangements for children in Year 4 and Year 5 to have a block of 10 swimming lessons next half term. Year 5 missed out on swimming last year due to lockdown, and our Year 4 traditionally swim in the summer term enabling us to fulfil the water safety and swimming element of the PE National Curriculum. We were keen to get these lessons in before the summer holiday. Swim England is encouraging families and schools to return to pools to ensure that children have not missed out on water safety and swimming lessons before any trips to the beach or pools during the holidays.

Class Trips
