Dressing for the Weather – Everyone with a Sunhat Please!

A Safety Plea Regarding the Driveway and Arrival Times

We strongly recommend that families do not arrive for school any earlier than 8.35 am. The driveway is in constant use by staff until that time, and children playing on the drive and grass before then are in great danger. I appreciate that some families need to arrive early for various reasons. If you are in a car, we recommend that you and your child stay in the car until after 8.35 am. If you are walking, including those who are arriving for Breakfast Club, please use the pedestrian path, and always ensure your children stay with you. We have had a couple of near misses lately, with small children scooting or running ahead of their adults and then waiting on the driveway where cars are still coming in. *Please be aware that a child on the drive or grass cannot be seen by anyone driving in and this poses a real danger.* Finally, please remember that all children must stay with their adults until the gate is opened - there shouldn't be any children running around or playing chasing games.
