**Bob Weighton's Visit**

We were honoured to welcome Mr Bob Weighton to Andrews' Endowed on Monday. At 111 years old, Bob amazed us all and captivated his audience of children from Acorns to Y6. Bob told the children all about his life, and answered a range of mature and perceptive questions which they had prepared in class discussions. It was particularly thought provoking that Lucy from Y6 was celebrating her 11<sup>th</sup> birthday on the day of the visit. Bob gave some very clear messages about the need to make things from recycled materials rather than buying new, and about respecting the environment. Our favourite bit of the visit was when he told us all about Christmases 100 years ago. I was very proud of all the children who were selected to meet Bob, for their polite manners and their careful listening, but especially Elijah and Isobel from Acorns, who sat and listened for a whole hour, declining the option to return to class part way through the event!
